1. The applicant will be held liable for any damage caused by the movement. The Paulding County Engineer assumes no responsibility for damage to the applicant's equipment or load being moved due to any such failure. The applicant agrees to compensate the Paulding County Engineer for any damage to a roadway or road structure and also to hold Paulding County and the Paulding County Engineer harmless from all claims, damages, or proceedings of any kind and from all responsibility for person injury or property damage (public or private) caused directly or indirectly as a result of the transportation of said vehicle(s) or object(s).
2. The applicant must file a certificate of his liability insurance, showing that he has procured adequate insurance to cover the provisions of paragraph one.
3. The permit shall be in possession of the driver at all times during the progress of transportation and will be shown on demand to any police officer, state highway patrolman, or employee of the Paulding County Engineer's Office.
4. The permission granted restricts the movement of the vehicle(s) or object(s) to the roads specified, between the points designated, and within the time allotted.
5. Movements under a special hauling permit shall be made during daylight hours only and in such a manner to impede the least possible extent the normal traffic.
6. The operator of the vehicle must comply with all laws, rules and regulations covering movement of traffic over roadways and streets.
7. Reductions in legal weight posted on roadways and bridges must be obeyed.
8. Traffic control and safety devices must be provided to meet the Paulding County Engineer's specifications.
9. Alterations and moving of electric and telephone lines that will interfere with the moving will be done by the utility concerned. The applicant shall make their own arrangements in advance of the actual moving with the utility concerned for such alterations.
10. The Paulding County Sheriff's Office must be notified at least two weeks prior to movement to schedule an escort, if needed, at the expense of the applicant. This notification will be done through the Paulding County Engineer's Office.
